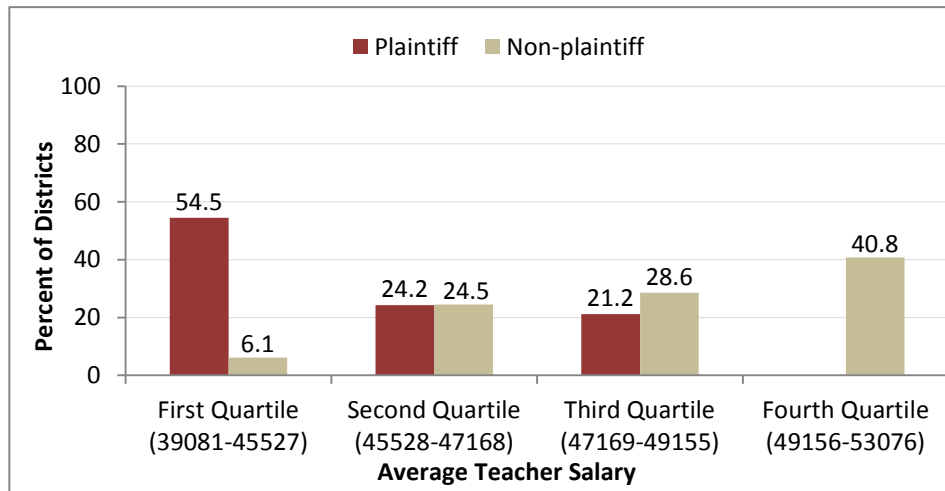

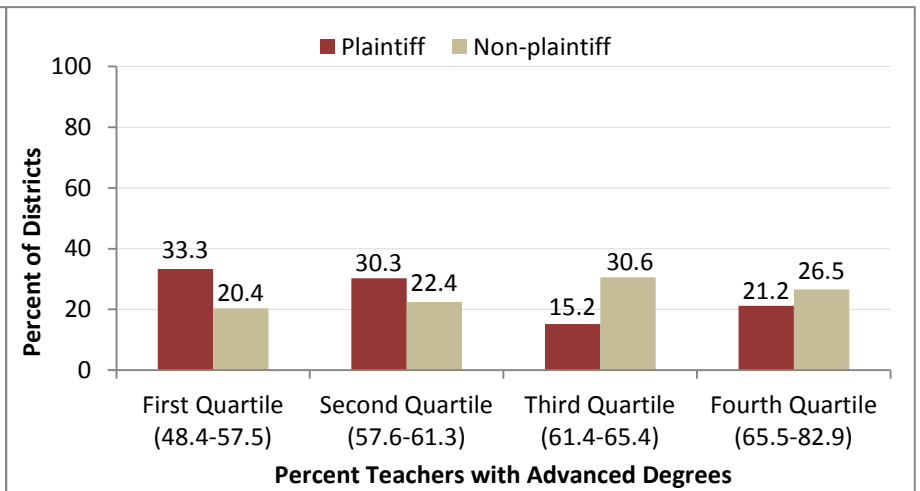

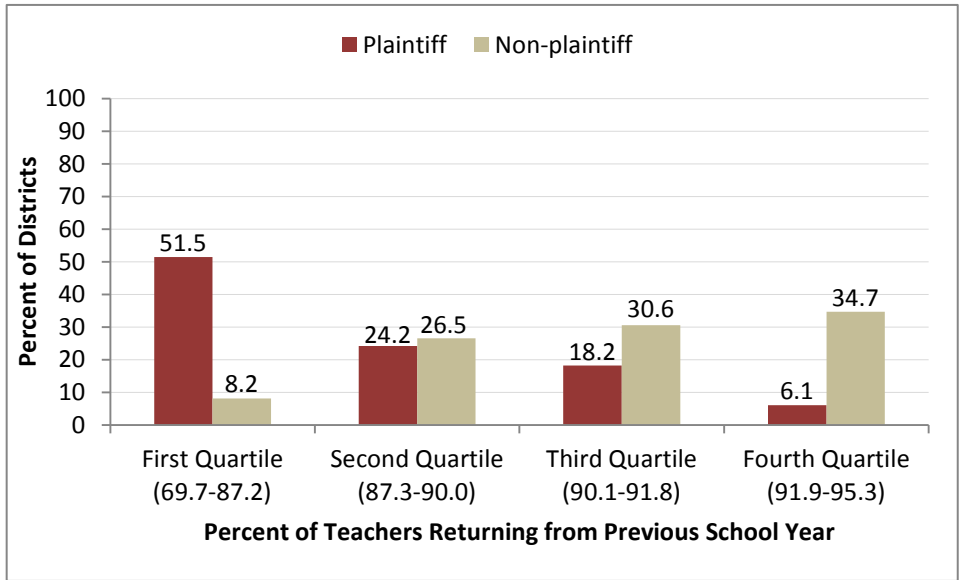
**Percent of Districts by Average Teacher Salary**



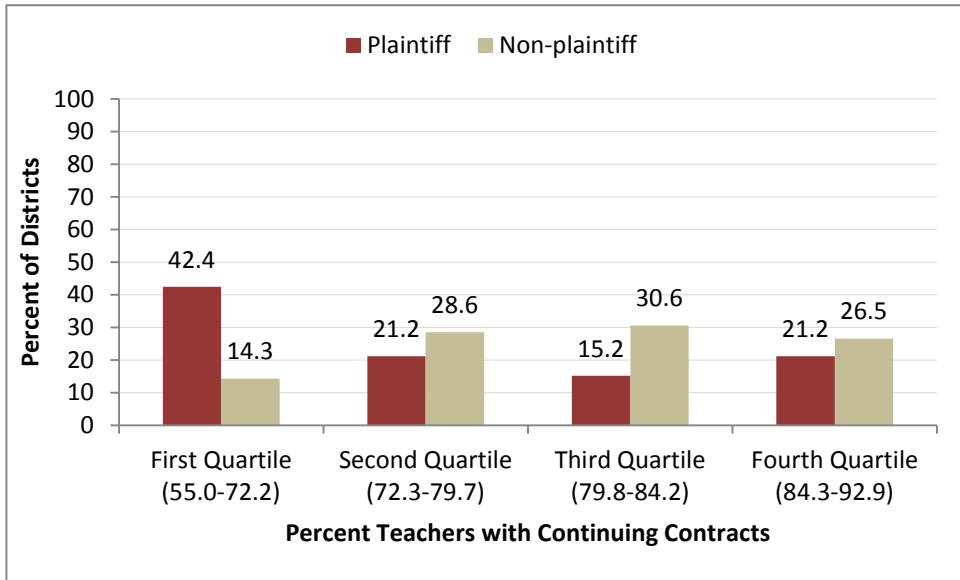
**Percent of Districts by Teachers with Advanced Degrees**



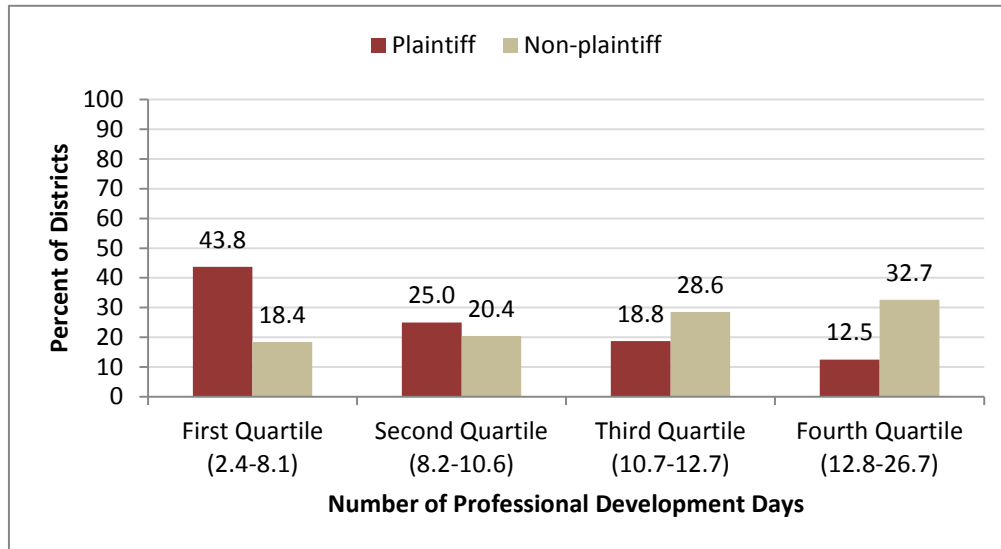
**Percent of Districts by Teachers Returning from Previous School Year**
