I am highly concerned for the lack of numbers on Native Americans living in the Staye of Carolina with ALL departments serving people. There is an overwhelming lack of representation in the state. SC is so far behind other states in recognizing Native American people, Federal and State tribes. There is also a hue gap in culturally appropriate Services that contributes to recidivism in prisons and a revolving door that is spinning wildly out of control in the following areas: substance use relapse, less than 1% reunification rate for families, poor services for Native American Veterans, zero services for addressing mental health, traditional medicine and maternity/lactation care, preventative services for youth, and minimal to no understanding of the function of ICWA laws, the list goes on! Please help community outreach by implementing state policies on training for culturally appropriate services to stop the revolving door by providing a continuum of care. Thank you!
