- II. The House Legislative Oversight Committee (Committee) was called to order by Chairman Wm. Weston J. Newton on Wednesday, January 7, 2015, at 11:15 a.m. in Room 521 of the Blatt Building, Columbia, South Carolina. All Members were present, except Representative James E. Smith, Jr. Chairman Newton made brief welcoming remarks and general announcements.

A committee discussion was held on a recommendation for the Speaker as to a Suggested House of Representatives' Legislative Oversight Review Schedule and changes made to those suggestions after an initial draft was provided to committee members in a meeting packet. On motion of Representative Kirkman Finlay, III, with unanimous consent, the Suggested House of Representatives' Legislative Oversight Review Schedule as presented to the committee on January 7, 2015, was adopted.
