H 3242 Joint Resolution, By Anderson, Breeland and McMahan

A Joint Resolution requiring the Chief Insurance Commissioner to recommend to the General Assembly legislative changes that will encourage a greater number of insurance companies to operate in this State in such a manner as to foster broad-based competition in the market place and result in reduced premiums for the State's consumers.
