

## Session 111 - (1995-1996)

### H\*4850 (Rat #0434, Act #0518 of 1996) Joint Resolution, By Loftis and Anderson

A Joint Resolution to provide that the school day of January 12, 1996, missed by the students of the school district of Greenville County when the district's schools were closed due to snow and ice conditions is exempted from the make-up requirement of the Defined Minimum Plan that full school days missed due to extreme weather or other circumstances be made up.
