### **S\*1071 (Rat #0392, Act #0353 of 1994) General Bill, By Bryan**

A Bill to amend Section 40-43-360, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to definitions under the Pharmacy Act including the definition of "practitioner" as one licensed to prescribe drugs, so as to include physicians' assistants and therapeutically certified optometrists, and to authorize physicians to dispense noncontrolled drugs at free clinics if no pharmacist is available and if the drugs are properly labeled.-amended title
