S 1153 General Bill, By Elliott

Summary: Hunting

A BILL TO AMEND SECTIONS 50-11-2600, 50-11-2610, 50-11-2620, AND 50-11-2630, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE HUNTING OF FOXES AND COYOTE IN ENCLOSED AREAS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT COYOTES MAY NOT BE HUNTED IN ENCLOSED AREAS, DOGS ARE ALLOWED TO PURSUE FOXES WITHIN AN ENCLOSED AREA, THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES MAY NOT ISSUE COYOTE HUNTING ENCLOSURE PERMITS, AN ENCLOSED AREA MAY NOT BE CONSTRUCTED WITHIN TWENTY-FIVE YARDS OF A PROPERTY LINE, A COMMERCIAL FUR LICENSE DOES NOT PERMIT A TRAPPER TO POSSESS, SELL, BARTER, OR EXCHANGE LIVE COYOTES TAKEN BY A TRAPPER, AND LIVE COYOTES MAY NOT BE SOLD OR TRANSFERRED TO AN OWNER OR ENCLOSURE OPERATOR OF A PERMITTED ENCLOSURE BY THE TRAPPER WHO TOOK THE ANIMAL.
