Summary: Off-road motorcycle and ATV activity, study committee created to study opportunities for trails on state owned land

A JOINT RESOLUTION TO CREATE A STATE GOVERNMENT INTERAGENCY STUDY COMMITTEE TO STUDY STEPS TO BE TAKEN TO PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR TRAILS ON STATE OWNED OR LEASED LAND OR PRIVATELY OWNED LAND FOR OFF-ROAD MOTORCYCLE AND ALL TERRAIN VEHICLE RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY; TO PROVIDE FOR THE STUDY COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP; AND TO REQUIRE THAT THE STUDY COMMITTEE REPORT ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BEFORE JANUARY 14, 2003, AT WHICH TIME THE STUDY COMMITTEE IS ABOLISHED.
