Summary: Study Committee, merger of MUSC School of Pharmacy and USC School of Pharmacy

A JOINT RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A JOINT PHARMACY PROGRAMS MERGER STUDY COMMITTEE TO STUDY RESPECTIVE PROGRAMS AT THE COLLEGE OF PHARMACY OF THE MEDICAL UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH CAROLINA AND THE SCHOOL OF PHARMACY AT THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH CAROLINA AND THE FEASIBILITY AND ADVISABILITY OF MERGING THE TWO PROGRAMS, TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMMITTEE TO MAKE A REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY NO LATER THAN MAY 15, 2005, ON THE ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES OF THE MERGER OF THE TWO PROGRAMS, TO PROVIDE FOR THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMITTEE, ITS DUTIES, EXPENSES, AND STAFFING, AND TO PROVIDE THAT A MERGER OF THE TWO PHARMACY PROGRAMS MAY NOT OCCUR BEFORE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY HAS RECEIVED THE RESULTS OF THE STUDY.
