A Bill to amend Article 1 of Chapter 17 of Title 31, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the Uniform Standards Code for Mobile Homes, so as to provide for a Uniform Standards Code for Manufactured Housing, further define mobile home, conform the provisions to Federal Laws and Regulations, provide for a monitoring inspection fee and an Administrative Hearing Officer and penalties.
