Summary: Provisions to become ineligible to receive a special restricted driver's license

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-1-748, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN ISSUED A RESTRICTED DRIVER'S LICENSE UNDER CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF LAW SUBSEQUENTLY BECOMING INELIGIBLE FROM BEING ISSUED A SPECIAL RESTRICTED DRIVER'S LICENSE UNDER THESE PROVISIONS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WHOSE DRIVER'S LICENSE HAS BEEN SUSPENDED BECAUSE OF HIS REFUSAL TO SUBMIT TO TESTING FOR CERTAIN LEVELS OF ALCOHOL CONCENTRATION OR REGISTERS A CERTAIN LEVEL OF ALCOHOL CONCENTRATION AND WHO HAS BEEN ISSUED A RESTRICTED DRIVER'S LICENSE SUBSEQUENTLY, IS INELIGIBLE FROM BEING ISSUED A SPECIAL RESTRICTED DRIVER'S LICENSE.
