**S 0252 General Bill, By Hayes, Branton, Alexander, Ravenel, Leatherman, Grooms, J.V. Smith, Peeler, Giese, Wilson, Gregory, Hawkins, Ritchie and Fair**

**Summary:** Beer and wine, minors under twenty-one aiding law enforcement investigation may not be charged; Alcoholic beverages

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 61-4-100, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO CRIMINAL CHARGES BROUGHT AGAINST SELLERS AND BUYERS FOR THE UNLAWFUL PURCHASE OF BEER OR WINE BY A MINOR, SO AS TO PROHIBIT A MINOR FROM BEING CHARGED WITH UNLAWFULLY PURCHASING BEER OR WINE IF THE MINOR MADE THE PURCHASE AS PART OF AN INVESTIGATION BEING CONDUCTED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT.
