H*3298 (Rat #0341, Act #0326 of 1986) General Bill, By J.H. Toal and Sheheen

A Bill to amend Article 1, Chapter 3 of Title 23, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division, by adding Section 23-3-45 so as to provide that the Division is authorized to accept fingerprints of applicants for admission to the South Carolina Bar and, to the extent provided for by Federal Law, to exchange state, multistate, and federal criminal history records with the South Carolina Board of Law Examiners for licensing purposes.
