H 3319 General Bill, By J.M. Baxley, Alexander, R.A. Barber, R.S. Corning, Jennings, I.K. Rudnick, J.S. Shissias, C.Y. Waites, Walker, C.C. Wells, J.B. Wilder and D.A. Wright

A Bill to amend Section 14-7-810, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the reasons for disqualification of jurors, so as to provide that a person who is blind, hearing or speech impaired, or physically handicapped may not be disqualified to act as a juror or be excluded from a jury list or jury service because of these handicaps; and to amend Section 15-27-110, relating to interpreters for the deaf, so as to provide that an interpreter be provided when a deaf person is a juror and provide criteria for the use of an interpreter when used to assist a deaf juror.
