Summary: Concealed weapons permit

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 23-31-215, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF CONCEALED WEAPONS PERMITS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WHO HOLDS A VALID OUT-OF-STATE PERMIT MAY CARRY A WEAPON IN THIS STATE, TO DELETE THE PROVISION THAT REQUIRES SLED TO MAINTAIN A LIST OF STATES WHICH HAVE WEAPONS PERMIT RECIPROCAL AGREEMENTS WITH THIS STATE, AND DELETE THE PROVISION THAT REQUIRES THIS STATE TO HONOR A WEAPONS PERMIT ISSUED BY ANOTHER STATE AS LONG AS THE OTHER STATE REQUIRES AN APPLICANT FOR A PERMIT TO SUCCESSFULLY PASS A CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK AND A COURSE IN FIREARM TRAINING SAFETY.
