Summary: Coastal municipality police department, criminal jurisdiction of; Law Enforcement, Political Subdivisions, Conservation

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 5-7-150, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO A COASTAL MUNICIPALITY'S CRIMINAL JURISDICTION, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF A MUNICIPALITY WHICH IS BOUNDED BY THE ATLANTIC OCEAN TO THE EAST AND WHICH IS COMPLETELY SURROUNDED ON THE REMAINING BOUNDARIES BY ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY EXERCISES CONCURRENT CRIMINAL JURISDICTION WITH THE SURROUNDING MUNICIPALITY'S POLICE DEPARTMENT ALONG THE PORTION OF ANY UNITED STATES HIGHWAY PASSING THROUGH THE SURROUNDED MUNICIPALITY.
