H 3690 General Bill, By Harrison and Lourie

Summary: DUI, second or subsequent violation; court to immobilize vehicle

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 56-5-2931 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE COURT SHALL IMMOBILIZE VEHICLES OWNED BY A PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION OF THE OFFENSE OF UNLAWFULLY OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WHICH UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL, DRUGS, OR A COMBINATION OF BOTH UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; AND TO AMEND SECTION 56-5-2940, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO PENALTIES FOR THE UNLAWFUL OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL, DRUGS, OR A COMBINATION OF BOTH, AND DRIVING WITH AN UNLAWFUL ALCOHOL CONCENTRATION, SO AS TO REVISE THE PENALTY FOR A SECOND OFFENSE.
