A JOINT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE XVII OF THE CONSTITUTION OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1895, RELATING TO MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS, BY ADDING SECTION 15 SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENACTMENT OF A LAW OR CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT INITIATED BY A PETITION SIGNED BY NO FEWER THAN TEN PERCENT OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE AT THE LAST GENERAL ELECTION FOLLOWED BY A MAJORITY VOTE IN FAVOR OF THE PROPOSED LAW OR CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY BY LAW PRESCRIBE ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR AN INITIATIVE PETITION IF THE ADDED REQUIREMENTS ARE CONSISTENT WITH THIS SECTION.
