Summary: Post-conviction relief proceedings

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 17-27-20, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO PERSONS WHO MAY INSTITUTE A POST-CONVICTION RELIEF PROCEEDING, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON MAY BRING A POST-CONVICTION RELIEF PROCEEDING IF HE HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF, AND SENTENCED FOR, A CRIME AND MAY BE ENTITLED TO RELIEF FROM THE CONVICTION OR THE SENTENCE UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.
