H 4041 Joint Resolution, By Koon, M.O. Alexander, L.E. Bennett, G.A. Brown, D.M. Bruce, P.M. Burch, C.D. Chamblee, J.G. Felder, McKay, M. McLeod, Rhoad, Sharpe, J.R. Shirley, R. Smith, J.J. Snow, D.C. Waldrop, J.B. Wilder and D. Williams

A Joint Resolution providing that, with reference to the proposal of the State Superintendent of Education to merge fifty-two supervisory positions into twenty-four positions with the result that more than twenty-eight employees of the State Department of Education could lose their jobs, the persons ultimately selected to fill the twenty-four positions must come from the group of persons occupying the current fifty-two positions, providing that those employees in the current group of fifty-two who have less than five years before retirement shall have priority for the twenty-four positions to be filled, and requiring that certain procedures be followed before the State Superintendent's proposal may be implemented.
