Summary: State employees, payroll deductions, Comptroller General to oversee membership organizations; Public Officers

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 8-11-83, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS FOR DUES OF VARIOUS MEMBERSHIPS FROM THE COMPENSATION PAID STATE EMPLOYEES FOR DUES FOR SPECIFIC MEMBERSHIP ORGANIZATIONS AND THE RESTRICTIONS IN THESE ORGANIZATIONS RECEIVING THE AMOUNTS WITHHELD, SO AS TO ADD A REQUIREMENT THAT NO PAYROLL DEDUCTION IS ALLOWED UNLESS THE MEMBER RECEIVES SPECIFIC AND TANGIBLE BENEFITS FROM MEMBERSHIP NOT AVAILABLE TO NONMEMBER STATE EMPLOYEES AND TO REQUIRE THE COMPTROLLER GENERAL ANNUALLY TO MAKE A WRITTEN DETERMINATION THAT MEMBERSHIP ORGANIZATIONS ARE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENT FOR PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS TO CONTINUE.
