## H\*4337 (Rat #0466, Act #0363 of 2002) General Bill, By Campsen, Chellis, Barfield, Harrell and Easterday

**Summary:** Estimated Income Tax Payment Reform Act; deductions from taxable income for volunteer emergency workers including HAZMAT workers; discount for payment of sales tax for electronic filing
