MEMORIAL HIGHWAY" IN HONOR OF DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. AND TO ERECT APPROPRIATE SIGNS OR MARKERS ALONG THIS PORTION OF THE HIGHWAY CONTAINING THE WORDS "THE MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., MEMORIAL HIGHWAY".
