A Bill to amend Section 46-41-10, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to definitions in regard to the regulation of dealers and handlers of agricultural products, so as to revise the definition of "agricultural products" to include cotton, thereby making dealers in cotton subject to these regulatory provisions.
