Summary: Public schools, food and drink; must comply with certain dietary requirements

A BILL TO AMEND CHAPTER 5, TITLE 59, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 59-5-73, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT NO PUBLIC SCHOOL MAY HAVE AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS, IN THE CAFETERIA OR ON THE SCHOOL GROUNDS, FOOD OR DRINK THAT EXCEEDS OR DOES NOT COMPLY WITH DIETARY LIMITATION REQUIREMENTS PROVIDED FOR IN THE NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH ACT AND THE MOST RECENT APPLICABLE DIETARY GUIDELINES FOR AMERICANS, TO PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS, AND TO PROVIDE THAT ANY SCHOOL WHICH FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE PROVISIONS SHALL LOSE CERTAIN STATE FUNDING.
