### **H\*4873 (Rat #0619, Act #0457 of 1994) General Bill, By W.S. Houck**

A Bill to amend Section 44-53-280, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to registration of professionals under narcotics and controlled substances use incidental to their profession, so as to revise the dates for expiration and renewal of registrations; and to provide staggered registrations.
