A BILL TO AMEND CHAPTER 1, TITLE 37, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO GENERAL PROVISIONS AND DEFINITIONS IN THE CONSUMER PROTECTION CODE, BY ADDING SECTION 37-1-410 SO AS TO REQUIRE A PERSON OR BUSINESS THAT SUBMITS TO A CONSUMER CREDIT REPORTING AGENCY AN INDIVIDUAL'S NAME AS A CREDIT RISK OR AS HAVING BAD CREDIT TO NOTIFY THE INDIVIDUAL OF THAT FACT IN WRITING, AND TO PROVIDE A CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS SECTION.
