H 4911 General Bill, By W.J. Young and McGee

A BILL TO AMEND CHAPTER 13, TITLE 8, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 8-13-1375, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT PERSON INELIGIBLE TO VOTE OR WHO HAVE BEEN CONVICTED OF CERTAIN CRIMES MAY NOT ENGAGE IN SPECIFIED CAMPAIGN PRACTICES OR SERVE IN SPECIFIED CAPACITIES FOR ANY POLITICAL PARTY, CAMPAIGN, OR CANDIDATE FOR PUBLIC OFFICE, OR IN CONNECTION WITH ANY ISSUE TO BE VOTED ON BY THE QUALIFIED ELECTORATE IN AN ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THIS STATE, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.
