S 0645 General Bill, By Peeler and Hutto

Summary: Agricultural conservation easement, farmer permitted operation; Agriculture, Property

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 46-53-200, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A FARMER WHO HAS ENTERED INTO AN AGRICULTURAL CONSERVATION EASEMENT, IN A COUNTY WHERE A PRIORITY AGRICULTURAL LAND AREA HAS BEEN DESIGNATED, AND WHO SEEKS TO EXPAND A PERMITTED OPERATION IS REQUIRED TO SATISFY SITING AND MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS BUT IS NOT REQUIRED TO RECEIVE APPROVAL OR TO UNDERGO PUBLIC HEARINGS OR A PUBLIC NOTICE PERIOD.
