Summary: State fiscal stabilization funds

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO EXPRESS THE BELIEF OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT SHOULD THE GOVERNOR REQUEST STATE FISCAL STABILIZATION FUNDS THAT ANY CONDITIONS IMPOSED BY CONGRESS ON THE RECEIPT AND EXPENDITURE OF THESE FUNDS ONLY APPLY TO THE STATE DURING THE PERIOD THAT THE FUNDS ARE RECEIVED AND EXPENDED AND DO NOT OBLIGATE THE STATE TO ANY FURTHER CONDITIONS, AND IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO NOT IMPLEMENT ANY NEW OR INCREASE ANY EXISTING REVENUE RAISING MEASURE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ANY FEE, FINE, OR TAX, TO SUPPORT ANY NEW PROGRAM OR INCREASE IN FUNDING OF ANY EXISTING PROGRAM RESULTING FROM THE RECEIPT OF STATE FISCAL STABILIZATION FUNDS.
