**S 0747 General Bill, By Saleeby, Holland, Land, J.A. Martin and P.B. McLeod**

A Bill to enact the Motor Vehicle Chop Shop, Stolen, and Altered Property Act, to provide penalties, including forfeiture, for violations, and to amend Section 16-1-10, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to crimes classified as felonies, so as to include offenses established in this Act.
