S 0856 Joint Resolution, By Thomas, Courtney, Giese, Martin, Mescher, Peeler, Ryberg, Waldrep and Wilson *Similar (H 3812)*

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to Article XVII of the Constitution of South Carolina, 1895, by adding Section 16 so as to prohibit the State of South Carolina or any of its political subdivisions from using race, sex, color, ethnicity, or national origin as a criterion for either discriminating against or granting preferential treatment to any individual or group in the operation of the State's system of public employment, public education, or public contracting in order to create or implement an affirmative action program.
