S 0925 Joint Resolution, By Giese, Washington, Reese, Hayes, Wilson, Branton, Leventis, Rankin and Glover

Summary: Public officers, state employees; time lost from work due to Hurricane Floyd not to be made up; Human Resources Division

A JOINT RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE THAT STATE AGENCIES OR DEPARTMENTS HAVING EMPLOYEES LOCATED WITHIN THOSE COUNTIES WHOSE PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT WAS CLOSED BY THE GOVERNOR ON SEPTEMBER 14, 15, OR 16, 1999, BECAUSE OF HURRICANE FLOYD MAY NOT REQUIRE THOSE EMPLOYEES TO MAKE UP TIME LOST FROM WORK, TO PROVIDE THAT EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA LOCATED WITHIN THOSE COUNTIES WHOSE PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT WAS CLOSED BY THE GOVERNOR AS A RESULT OF HURRICANE FLOYD ARE NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE HAZARDOUS WEATHER POLICY TO MAKE UP TIME LOST FROM WORK BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1999, AND TO PROVIDE FOR COMPENSATORY TIME FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES.
