A Bill to amend Section 44-17-440, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the custody and transport of persons to mental health facilities, so as to authorize local law enforcement agencies, local governing bodies, and directors of community mental health centers to arrange an alternative transportation program for nonviolent persons requiring mental health treatment.-amended title
