A Joint Resolution to direct the Joint Legislative Committee on Aging in conjunction with the Health Care Planning and Oversight Committee, the State Department of Health and Human Services, the Division on Aging, Office of the Governor, and the Department of Revenue and Taxation to study the effect of immigration on health care costs and other aging network services and tax policies relative to immigrants and to submit a report and recommendations to the General Assembly by January 1, 1997.
