## **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill is expected to increase General Fund Medicaid expenditures by approximately \$375,000 and also increase Federal matching fund expenditures by approximately \$875,000 annually.

## **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

## **State Expenditure**

House Bill 3160 requires anyone who wants to purchase ephedrine, pseudoephedrine and propanolamine from a pharmacy to first obtain a written prescription from a physician or another licensed person who has prescriptive authority.

The Department of Labor, Licensing & Regulation and the Department of Health & Environmental Control both report that this bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.

**Public Employee Benefit Authority.** PEBA indicates that if the Employee Insurance Plan were required to cover these medications, they would be placed in a tier that would not result in a cost to the Plan. Therefore, this bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.

**Department of Health & Human Services.** The agency estimates this bill would cost from \$1,000,000 to \$1,250,000 in payments for vaccines for Medicaid-eligible and uninsured children. The annual expenditure increase to the General Fund is estimated at \$375,000. The annual expenditure increase to Federal Funds is estimated at \$875,000. These estimates are based on a 30% state/70% Federal matching rate.
