**Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

**State Expenditure**

This bill establishes a committee to review all existing state education statutes and report to the General Assembly those statutes that are obsolete. In addition, it requires the State Department of Education to develop a system for providing services and technical assistance to districts on a regional basis. SDE will monitor the professional development of teachers, staff, and administrators in districts it determines are underperforming as well as the operations of the school boards in order to determine if they are operating efficiently and effectively.

The Senate, the House of Representatives, and Education Oversight Committee indicate that expenses such as mileage, per diem, and subsistence can be absorbed within current appropriations.
