**Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill would increase General Fund expenditures by a minimal amount and could be absorbed by the agency. No impact on Federal Funds or Other Funds is expected.

**Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

**State Expenditure**

This bill adds Chapter 33 to Title 33 to enact the “Revised Uniform State Revenue Unincorporated Nonprofit Association Act”. The bill defines terms, specifies applicability, sets forth powers of the associations, specifies liability, and sets forth the process by which legal action against an association is adjudicated.

The Secretary of State’s Office indicates there will be a minimal cost for filing registered agents’ information and making that information available to the public. Minimal cost is expected with creating new forms for the registered agent and for mergers. This bill would increase General Fund expenditures by a minimal amount and could be absorbed by the agency. There is no anticipated impact on Federal Funds or Other Funds.
