Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Amended by Senate Labor, Commerce, and Industry on February 14, 2017

State Expenditure

Under existing law, a security officer awaiting approval for registration from the State Law Enforcement Division (SLED) may, with the exception of carrying a firearm or exercising arrest authority, perform the duties of a security officer for up to twenty days after SLED's receipt of the officer's application for registration. The bill, as amended by the Senate Labor, Commerce, and Industry, extends the time period within which an unregistered security officer awaiting SLED's registration approval may perform security officer duties to thirty days after SLED's receipt of the registration application.

State Law Enforcement Division. The department reports that the bill as amended will have no effect on the processing of security officer registrations and will therefore result in no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds.
