

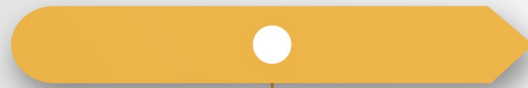


# Timeline of an Inmate Day

**\*The day the inmate arrives, he is given an orientation packet to read containing medical and grievance information. On that day he also sees medical for a brief initial interview. The next morning, security and other staff conduct a verbal orientation on the same topics.**

**\*visitation is from 12-2pm. R&E inmates are allowed 1 visit every 2 weeks.**
