- 1860 State Penitentiary (later named Central Correctional Institution) opened
- 1892 Wateree River Correctional Institution opened (Replaced original building in 1952)
- 1938 Stevenson Correctional Institution opened
- 1951 Walden Correctional Institution opened
- 1962 Manning Correctional Institution later renamed Manning Reentry and Work Release Center opened
- 1964 Harbison Correctional Institution for Women opened
- 1964 Pre-Release Center opened (renamed a decade later to the Watkins Pre-Release Center)
- 1965 Mid-State Pre-Release Center opened (replaced by Campbell in 1975)
- 1965 The State Penitentiary was renamed the Central Correctional Institution
- 1966 MacDougall Correctional Institution, a Youth Correctional Center opened
- 1966 Midlands Reception and Evaluation Center opened (originally the Reception and Evaluation Center)
- 1968 Blue Ridge Community Pre-Release Center opened
- 1968 Maximum Detention Retraining Center opened
- 1969 Givens Youth Correctional Institution opened
- 1970 Coastal Community Pre-Release Center opened
- 1970 Goodman Correctional Institution opened (originally designated for older inmates)
- 1970 Piedmont Community Pre-Release Center opened
- 1971 Catawba Community Pre-Release Center opened
- 1973 Duncan Correctional Center opened
- 1973 Harbison Correctional Institution closed
- 1973 New Prospect Correctional Center opened
- 1973 Northside Pre-Release Center opened
- 1973 Savannah River Community Pre-Release Center opened (later renamed Lower Savannah Community Pre-Release Center)
- 1973 Women's Correctional Institution opened
- 1974 Cherokee Correctional Center opened
- 1974 Hillcrest Correctional Center includes Intake Service Center opened
- 1974 Greenville Central Camp opened
- 1974 Greenwood County Prison Camp later renamed Greenwood Correctional Center later renamed Greenwood unit at Leath opened
- 1974 Laurens County Prison camp opened (SCDC later renamed Laurens Correctional Center)
- 1974 Lexington Correctional Center opened
- 1974 Oaklawn Correctional Center opened
- 1974 Travelers Rest Correctional Center opened
- 1975 Aiken Youth Correctional Center opened
- 1975 Campbell Pre-Release Center replaced the Mid-State Community Pre-Release Center
- 1975 Greenville Central Camp no longer noted in the SCDC Institutional Listing
- 1975 Kirkland Correctional Institution opened (later renamed to Kirkland Reception and Evaluation Center)
- 1975 Lower Savannah Pre-Release Center opened
- 1975 Mid-State Pre-Release Center closed (replaced by Campbell)
- 1975 New Prospect Correctional Center closed (Inmates transferred to Northside)
- 1975 Palmer Pre-Release Center opened
- 1975 Sumter Correctional Center opened (later renamed North Sumter Correctional Institution)
- 1976 Maximum Detention Retraining Center no longer noted in the SCDC Institutional Listing
- 1979 North Sumter Correctional Institution closed
- 1980 Cherokee Correctional Center closed
