# Hierarchy for Security (Rehabilitative Services Division) at DJJ

# • Unit Manager (Equivalent to Captain)

o Assigned to Broad River Road Complex (BRRC) to direct operations and manage the unit to maintain safety and security among the juveniles.

### • Captain (Equivalent to Unit Manager)

o Assigned to an evaluation center or the detention center to direct operations and manage the facility to maintain safety and security among the juveniles.

### • Assistant Unit Manager (Equivalent to Lieutenant)

o Assigned to a Unit at BRRC on assigned shift to manage the unit to maintain safety and security among the juveniles.

# • Lieutenant (Equivalent to Assistant Unit Manager)

o Assigned to an evaluation center or the detention center on assigned shift to manage the facility to maintain safety and security among the juveniles.

# • Juvenile Specialist V (replaced previous title of Youth Specialist)

o Position with additional experience assigned to BRRC to supervise staff and maintain safety and security among the juveniles

# • Juvenile Specialist IV (Equivalent to Sergeant II and I)

o Position with additional experience assigned to BRRC to supervise staff and maintain safety and security among the juveniles

# • Sergeant II (Equivalent to Juvenile Specialist IV)

o Supervises staff on assigned shift to maintain safety and security among the juveniles

### • Sergeant I (Equivalent to Juvenile Specialist IV)

o Supervises staff on assigned shift to maintain safety and security among the juveniles

### • Juvenile Specialist III (Equivalent to Corporal)

o Position with additional experience assigned to BRRC to maintain safety and security among the juveniles

# • Corporal (Equivalent to Juvenile Specialist III)

o Position with additional experience assigned to an evaluation center or the detention center to maintain safety and security among the juveniles.

### • Juvenile Specialist II (Equivalent to JCO II)

o Position with additional experience assigned to BRRC to maintain safety and security among the juveniles.

### • JCO II (Equivalent to Juvenile Specialist II)

 Position with additional experience assigned to one of three evaluation centers to maintain safety and security among the juveniles. Also, serves as an entry level position for the Juvenile Detention Center to provide safety and security for the juveniles.

#### • Juvenile Specialist I (Equivalent to JCO I)

o Entry level position assigned to BRRC to maintain safety and security among the juveniles.

### • JCO I (Equivalent to Juvenile Specialist I)

o Entry level position assigned to various evaluation center facilities to maintain safety and security among the juveniles
