Mission:

The SC Emergency Management Division leads the state emergency management program by supporting local authorities to minimize the loss of life and property from all-hazard events.



Local First

- Agency resources (municipal / jurisdiction)
- Municipal and/or County resources

Mutual Aid Resources (County-to-County = Intrastate)

State Support

- State resources
- Contracted / vendor provided
- EMAC Resources (State-to-State = Interstate)
- National Guard

Federal Support

- Personnel
- Resources
- Financial



- Communication
- Personnel
- Transportation
- Returnable items = generators, forklifts, lights, cots, tents, barriers
- Non-returnable items = food, water, tarps, cleaning **and testing supplies**
 - PPE = **N95, surgical masks, gloves, gowns, face shields** (*new this year*)
- Technical experts
- Base camps
- Federal teams
- Federal GSA contracts



COUNTY
EOC

If available, the local EOC provides the resources



INCIDENT
COMMANDER

The Incident Commander will contact the local EOC to request resources

INCIDENT

Incident Commander (IC) manages the incident and resources

Resource Request Process



SCEMD

If support not available locally:

- Coordinates with nearby counties or
- Coordinates with the State EOC

COUNTY EOC



Federal support requests coordinated from the State EOC

FEDERAL SUPPORT

STATE EOC

Additional support provided by the State EOC

- Provides available resources
- Coordinates with everyone




INCIDENT COMMANDER (IC)

Command and control occurs at the incident

SCEMID


If support is needed:

- Coordinates with host county EOC
- Coordinates with DHEC and/or the State EOC
- **Coordinates directly with the NG (exception to the rule)**



Command and control occurs at the incident

- DHEC site
- Hospital site



Federal support requests coordinated from the State EOC

- Provides requested resources

Additional support provided by the State EOC

- Provides available personnel and resources
- Coordinates with everyone
