**A JOINT RESOLUTION**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina:

SECTION 1. 28 SECTION 3. This joint resolution takes effect thirty days after the  
29 completion of the 2010-2011 fiscal year in accordance with the  
30 provisions of Article III, Section 36(B)(3)(a), Constitution of  
31 South Carolina, 1895, and Section 11-11-320(D)(1) of the 1976  
32 Code.
