Bret Baronak, Project Director Carolina Thread Trail

Bret has been with the Carolina Thread Trail since 2016 and started as the Community Coordinator. In 2018 he moved into the role of Project Director. Bret's background has been largely focused in public sector land use and transportation planning. Throughout his career, he has specialized in bicycle and pedestrian planning. From 2006 to 2014, Bret served as the Bicycle, Greenways, and Pedestrian Coordinator in Palm Beach County, Florida, where he was responsible for planning, funding and elevating awareness for non-motorized transportation. While in Florida, he was active with the East Coast Greenway and served on the ECGA Trail Council. In late 2014, he moved to the Charlotte region and held the position of Senior Transportation Planner with the Gaston-Cleveland-Lincoln MPO. Bret is a native of western Pennsylvania and a graduate of Penn State University. He is an avid road and mountain cyclist and also enjoys hiking, travel, and spending time with family in his PA hometown when he has the opportunity.

Bret Baronak, Project Director for The Carolina Thread Trail. The Carolina Thread Trail is a regional network of trails that connect 2.9 million people in 15 counties in North and South Carolina. The Thread Trail is an example of unprecedented regional collaboration that works to connect people and communities to nature and each other through its 1,610 miles of trails, greenways and blueways. Bret will discuss the genesis of The Carolina Thread Trail organization, relationships with other land conservancies, government partnerships, funding and implementation of a regional vision.
