S 1031 General Bill, By Elliott

Summary: Ephedrine and pseudoephedrine products

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 44-53-398, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO REQUIREMENTS TO SELL PRODUCTS WHOSE SOLE ACTIVE INGREDIENT IS EPHEDRINE OR PSEUDOEPHEDRINE, INCLUDING THE REQUIREMENT THAT RETAILERS MAINTAIN A LOG OF SUCH SALES, SO AS TO FURTHER SPECIFY THAT SUCH LOG MUST BE ELECTRONIC AND THAT IT MUST BE CAPABLE OF CHECKING COMPLIANCE AGAINST LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL LAWS AND INTERFACING WITH OTHER STATES TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE AND TO REQUIRE THAT ADDITIONAL PURCHASER INFORMATION MUST BE RECORDED IN THE LOG.
