S 1091 General Bill, By Thomas

Summary: Unemployment benefits

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 41-35-110, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY FOR UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON SEEKING OR RECEIVING UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS MUST SUBMIT TO RANDOM DRUG SCREENING, AND THAT BENEFITS MUST TERMINATE IF HE TWICE FAILS THIS DRUG TEST; AND TO AMEND SECTION 41-35-120, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO DISQUALIFICATION FOR UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS MUST TERMINATE IF THE RECIPIENT TWICE FAILS A RANDOM DRUG TEST REQUIRED AS A CONDITION TO RECEIVE UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS.
