### **S\*1142 (Rat #0365, Act #0534 of 1992) Joint Resolution, By N.W. Smith, Hayes and Moore**

A Joint Resolution to require the State to provide continuity in fiscal matters, including uninterrupted payment of personnel, in the transfer of the South Carolina Guardian Ad Litem Program from the University of South Carolina to the State Workers' Compensation Fund.
