S 1229 General Bill, By McConnell

Summary: General Assembly

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 8-13-745, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO REPRESENTATION OF CLIENTS BY MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, SO AS TO PROHIBIT ANY MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OR AN ASSOCIATE FROM COMMUNICATING WITH ANY MEMBER OF OR STAFF PERSON WITHIN THE UNIFIED JUDICIAL SYSTEM, AN AGENCY, A COMMISSION, BOARD, DEPARTMENT, OR OTHER ENTITY REGARDING ANY PENDING CASE EXCEPT AS A COUNSEL TO A LITIGANT, AS A WITNESS, OR AS A PRO SE LITIGANT AS PERMITTED BY THE SOUTH CAROLINA APPELLATE COURT RULES.
