S 1423 General Bill, By Knotts

Summary: Law Enforcement Professionalism Act

A BILL TO AMEND CHAPTER 23, TITLE 23, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING ARTICLE 2, RELATING TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING COUNCIL, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR THE CREATION OF AN OFFICE OF PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS UNDER THE TRAINING COUNCIL AND THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACADEMY TO INVESTIGATE AND HEAR COMPLAINTS AGAINST LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, TO DETERMINE THE NECESSARY ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN AGAINST A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, TO PROVIDE FOR CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN PROCEEDINGS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR UNFOUNDED COMPLAINTS.
